NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:-

The installation of water supply pipe from the mains supply located in Stafford Road to

- a) connection to the existing supply to the two Cemetery Chapels;
- b) b) Extension of this supply to the northern end of the existing Cemetery to replace existing unchartered supply and provide a new tap supply for public use and within the potential extension to the Cemetery (see below)

Retrospective approval for the installation of two lone concrete plinths and twenty Above Ground Level Sanctums (ten per concrete plinth)

The installation of further concrete plinths and further Above Ground Level Sanctums for future use

Extension to the Cemetery to future proof burial provisions for the Town residents

The Council are liaising with the land owner with a view to purchasing a plot of land (circa 2 acres) directly adjoining the existing Cemetery boundary

County Archaeologist and Environmental Agency will be consulted in due course and Planning Permission for change of use
