Photography Competition 2022 Terms and conditions

with Uttoxeter in Bloom & the Friends of Bramshall Road Park

About the Competition

The competition is run by the Uttoxeter in Bloom Committee for the Uttoxeter Town Council in conjunction with the Friends of Bramshall Road Park group and is free to enter. The aim of the competition is to inspire everyone to share their passions of photography and the great outdoors.

Dates

- The deadline for entries is 5pm Friday, 30th September 2022.
- When the competition closes a selection of images from across all six categories will be displayed on the Uttoxeter Town Council website and Facebook page.

Conditions of Entry

- All entries must have been photographed in 2022 and the date provided
- All entries must be submitted by or with the permission of an adult (18 or over)
- Under 11 entries must be submitted with the permission of the child's parent/guardian.
- All entries must be submitted with a completed entry form for each category via email to admin.assistant@uttoxetowncouncil.org.uk
- Entrants can submit up to 2 images for each of the six categories, but no single image may be entered into more than one category (for example – an image cannot be entered into Gardens as well as Wonderful Wildlife)
- Entries must be submitted digitally
- It is not permitted to make any major physical change to the images. You may not, for example, add, move or remove objects, plants, animals, people and landscapes etc.
- Uttoxeter in Bloom and the Friends of Bramshall Road Park may request the original file for any shortlisted image and reserves the right to disqualify any image that it feels lacks authenticity.
- Judges may request a visit to the garden or area photographed

Categories

1. Gardens
2. Parks & Open Spaces
3. Wonderful Wildlife
4. Allotments
5. Urban Scenes (Town/Business/Roads/Streets etc)
6. Under 11's (Please capture wildlife, a plant, a garden, a park/open space, or an urban scene)

Eligibility

- The competition is free and open to all apart from anyone associated with the competition including Town Council employees, Judges, Councillors and Uttoxeter in Bloom and the Friends of Bramshall Road Park Committee members.

- The entrants must be the original image creator and solely hold the copyright
- It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that all necessary permissions are obtained from any person/property featured in a photograph

Judging

- A panel of judges will be appointed by the Uttoxeter in Bloom Committee and the Friends of Bramshall Road Park Committee to judge a shortlist of entries from each of the six categories
- The judges will then choose from the shortlist a winner for each of the six categories
- In addition, judges will award 'highly commended' and 'commended' where considered appropriate
- Judges hold the right to move entries to another category
- The judges reserve the right not to make any award if, in their opinion, none of the entries meet the required standard
- The decision of the judges is final, and no correspondence will be entered into

Winners

- The category winners will each receive a certificate and a prize. Highly Commended and Commended entrants, if awarded, will receive a certificate.
- The prize is non-transferable and must be claimed by its expiry date (if applicable).
- Uttoxeter in Bloom reserve the right to substitute the whole or part of any prize with an alternative of equal monetary value (but the entrant shall not have any right to request this)
- Winners will be announced and exhibited on Uttoxeter Town Council website and Facebook page, Friends of Bramshall Road Park Facebook page and shared with the Heart of England in Bloom

Copyright and Usage

- Entrants remain the copyright holder to any images submitted by themselves
- Entrants agree to allow Uttoxeter in Bloom, Friends of Bramshall Road Park and Uttoxeter Town Council to reproduce, enlarge, publish and exhibit for any purpose related to the competition in any medium, including print and digital for use in the press and on websites, including The Heart of England in Bloom
- The entrant is responsible for any claim made by a third party against the submission

By entering the competition, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these Terms & Conditions.
