

U BUGGYWALK NO 1 – BRAMSHALL PARK

DISTANCE 4 KM, 2.5M, 21 M CLIMB



One of a series of local walks to enjoy our wonderful countryside.

Remember any field paths can be a bit muddy and there are stiles. Keep your dog on a lead and take dog-poo bags and litter with you to the nearest bin.

This circular walk on tarmac pavements and paths is very flat and has mainly dropped kerbs at road junctions.



Leave the park onto Bramshall road and turn left. Shortly use the panda crossing and continue on the right. Stay on the main road past Sycamore Close and Birds Lane. At the new Development turn right into Ivinson Way. Stay on the right side of the road going straight on at Bartley Lane to go slightly uphill past the Bramshall Meadows First School.



At the end of the road turn right onto a tarmac public footpath which joins a road on in an older development. Keep to the left side to the road junction and then cross straight over following the footpath sign.

At the end turn right onto New Road and soon turn right then left on Tunnicliffe Way. Then almost immediately, turn left into New Road. Keep going straight on past a play area and the footpath narrows for a while. At Bentley road cross over and keep straight on ignoring side road until you turn right at Applewood Close. Cross to the left before a sharp turn to the left into a narrow path.



Go across the play area ignoring the passage to the left. The path gets a bit bumpy here before you cross the end of a road into another narrow path. At the end turn right onto Holly Road. Follow this road to the end ignoring side roads. Turn right onto Bramshall Road and cross to the left side when safe to do so. You are only a few steps back to the starting point.
