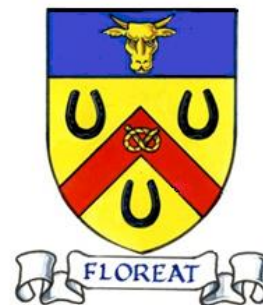


U WALK - UTTOXETER'S GREEN LINKS



One of a series of local walks to enjoy our wonderful countryside. Field paths can be a bit muddy and there are stiles. Keep your dog on a lead and take dog-poo bags and litter with you to the nearest bin.

Uttoxeter Town Route 32 - linking Uttoxeter Town 14 through Pinfold Street North to Uttoxeter Quarry



The link from Footpath 14 (Staffordshire Way) continues down Pinfold Street North to the Old Knotty Way. Cross over here by way of traffic lights and proceed left. Go through the gate on the right and over the railway crossing. This is Pinfold Street and either side used to be Bamfords Ltd works.



At the end of the Street facing is the Police Station. This is Balance Street - proceed right here. Follow it round to the left which is Market Street continuing into Market Place. In Market Place, the Conduit (Dr Samuel Johnson Memorial) will be on your right.



To the left is one of Uttoxeter's oldest building Ye Olde Talbot Public House. From the Conduit, proceed right to the Town War Memorial.



Proceed left (with St Mary's Parish Church on the right) into Church Street. Proceed left and continue onto High Street, turning right. Continue up the High Street, taking the next right turn into Bradley Street. Proceed past the bus station and take the first left past Thomas Alleyne's High School. Continue left onto Dove Bank to a footpath on the left with semi barriers on the side of the road. Continue along the Footpath, which will have the school playing fields on the right, and proceed to the end and then right into Eaton Street where the former gasworks was situated.



Cross over Gas Street into a path with a wood to the right, and houses on the left. On reaching the road, proceed right onto Park Street, and almost immediate right onto Pennycroft Lane. At the end there is a children's play area. There is a tarmac footpath to the left with green areas to the right. At the finger footpath post (where the tarmac finishes), follow this to a right turn. Follow this to an underpass and follow this through to Uttoxeter by-pass.
